



2023 "Rosaleda" Rosé of Tempranillo, Don Miguel Vineyard *Estate Grown, Estate Bottled*

Why "Rosaleda"?

Rosaleda means 'rose garden' in Spanish, and the name evokes the beautiful color of this rosé as well as the fragrant floral notes of this special vineyard.

The Don Miguel Vineyard

Named after the late patriarch of the Torres family, this vineyard is located in the Green Valley — the coolest, foggiest region of the Russian River, only ten miles from the Pacific. The European-style high density of over 2,000 vines per acre provides low yields and requires intensive labor; but the vines live longer and the grapes acquire better balance and greater concentration, as well as more elegance and finesse than with the traditional low density.

The Vinification

The grapes were harvested September 28th, gently whole-cluster pressed with a short time on the skins for gentle extraction of color and flavor, then cold fermented in stainless steel tanks at 55 degrees F. It was bottled in March 2024.

Tasting Notes

Lovely salmon color and engaging aromas of strawberries, white nectarines and cherries, plus some floral notes of honeysuckle. On the palate it is crisp and mineral, with refreshing acidity. Easy to drink and perfect as an apéritif or with foods like tapas, seafood and light dishes. I would recommend serving it at 46-48 F.
