Itinerary

The trip will kick off on Tuesday, April 1 in Santiago de Chile with a welcome dinner. Transportation will be provided for all airport arrivals that day.

The trip ends on Sunday, April 13, checking out from the hotel in the morning.

Cost and Program Details

Cost is \$11,000 per person. Includes full program for 11 nights and 10 days, transportation, breakfast and one main meal per day, guided tours, etc. Price based on double occupancy; additional charge for singles.

A \$1,000 non-refundable deposit per person is required to hold your reservation.

Itinerary

Tuesday, April 1: Transportation from the airport to the luxury five-star Mandarin Oriental Hotel in Santiago de Chile. Welcome dinner at La Bodeguita Torres.

Wednesday, April 2: Guided city tour of Santiago and lunch at Restaurante Baco.

Thursday, April 3: Drive to Haras de Pirque for tour and tasting at the winery. Lunch at Restaurant Hussonet followed by a visit to Viña Santa Rita. Transfer back to the hotel.

Friday, April 4: Transfer to Errazuriz Winery, visit and tasting. Drive to Valparaíso for lunch at Portofino restaurant, followed by a city tour. Transfer back to Santiago.

Saturday, April 5: Free day in Santiago for walking and shopping. Dinner at La Malaquita restaurant.

Sunday, April 6: Drive to Santa Cruz, visit and lunch at Clos Apalta (Lapostolle) winery. Transfer to hotel in Santa Cruz.

Monday, April 7: Drive to Curicó to visit Miguel Torres winery, wine tasting and paired lunch at La Bodeguita restaurant. Transfer to hotel in Santa Cruz.

Tuesday, April 8: Visit and tasting at Montes Apalta winery. Lunch at restaurant Fuegos de Apalta at the winery and early return to Hotel Mandarin in Santiago.

Wednesday, April 9: Free day before flying to Patagonia on Thursday.

Thursday, April 10: Flight from Santiago to Puerto Natales. Guided tour of Puerto Natales and dinner at Asador Patagónico restaurant. Stay at The Singular Hotel.

Friday, April 11: Guided tour of Cueva de Milodon and the grand Torres del Paine National Park. Lunch at Hotel Lago Grey. Return to hotel and dinner.

Saturday, April 12: Transfer from Puerto Natales to Punta Arenas, city tour and flight back to Santiago. Transfer to Mandarin Oriental hotel. Farewell Dinner at La Bodeguita de Miguel Torres, Santiago Restaurant.

Sunday, April 13: Departure from the hotel and transport to the airport. Possibility of extending your stay at the hotel for those interested in visiting Santiago leisurely, on your own.
